1. **Praise & Thanksgiving** (Psalm 148)

2. **Confession & Cleansing** (Psalm 51:1-2; Psalm 130:3-4; 1 John 1:9)
 - Sins of the flesh
 - Sins of the spirit

3. **Filling & Bearing**
 - Filling of the Spirit (Ephesians 5:18; 6:18)

 - Claim God's promise that all things work together for those who love Him and are called according to His purpose (Romans 8:28).
 - Call for the Lord's protection from the Evil One (Jude 9)
 - Pray for the demonstration of God's power through prayer by ordinary followers of Christ (James 5:16-18)
5. **Petition & Intercession** (1 Timothy 2:1; 1 Samuel 12:23; James 4:2b)
 - Personal Needs (yourself, spouse, family, work, etc)
 - Others in Need (extended family, neighbors, friends, workmates, etc)

6. **God's Kingdom & Christ's Return**
 - Ushering in the Kingdom (Matthew 6:10)
 - Consummation of the Kingdom (1 Corinthians 16:22; Revelation 22:20b; 2 Peter 3:12)
 - Fulfillment of global evangelization (Matthew 24:14)
7. **Local & Global** (Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Matthew 9:37-38)
 - Our congregations (leaders, members, seekers, spiritual growth, priorities, evangelism, etc.)
 - Our cities, communities and country (leaders, righteousness, spiritual harvests, destiny, etc)
 - Our world (leaders, political unrest, disasters, wars, injustice, suffering, AIDS, etc)
 - Our commission (mobilizers, senders, goers, intercessors, resourcers, unreached peoples, church planters, saved, persecuted, etc.)
