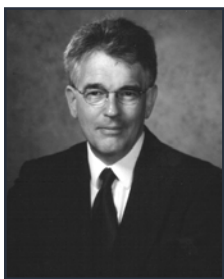

- ◆ Coordinator of Pastors Prayer Summits in Canada, having also led some of the Pastors Prayer Summits.
- ◆ Chair of the Program Working Group for the Canadian Prayer Assembly in Ottawa (May 2000) and Winnipeg (May 2001) national gatherings of thousands of Christians to intercede for Canada.
- ◆ Canadian Representative on Global Prayer Track of AD 2000 and Beyond Movement 1994-2000.

Dr. Thomas will lead this Prayer module at Alliance University College on the theme "Transforming Your Life, Congregation and Community Through Prayer."
