**Dr. T.V. Thomas** is well known for his work in the area of evangelism and missions. His deep commitment to the cause of world evangelism calls for extensive national and international travel to minister at churches, colleges, seminaries, conferences and consultations. In addition to his role as Director of the Centre for Evangelism & World Mission, he serves as:

- ◆ Coordinator, Canadian Prayer Track of VISION CANADA, 1994 -present. Under his catalytic role five prayer movements in Canada have become 27 prayer movements since 1995.
- ◆ Coordinator of Pastors Prayer Summits in Canada, having also led some of the Pastors Prayer Summits.
- ◆ Chair of the Program Working Group for the Canadian Prayer Assembly in Ottawa (May 2000) and Winnipeg (May 2001) national gatherings of thousands of Christians to intercede for Canada.
- ◆ Canadian Representative on Global Prayer Track of AD 2000 and Beyond Movement 1994-2000.

Dr. T.V. Thomas will lead this module, "**Fasting, Meditation and Prayer**", which will compare the differences of the biblical and non-biblical purposes, approaches and practices of fasting, meditation and prayer. Suggestions of variations are made to ensure a fit to one's needs. Detailed instructions are also given on how to prepare for, endure and come off a fast.
